Item #6 Standby generator is not centered on concrete pad and conduits enter generator through side of the enclosure. Conduits are to enter bottom of generator enclosure as noted on drawing E01, note 2;

AND WHEREAS, the report recommends the following Corrective Action:

Reposition generator on center of concrete pad to permit conduits to enter bottom of generator enclosure. Prime and paint edges of openings made in generator enclosure and plug openings.

AND WHEREAS, KGS Group Consulting Engineers have advised, if the Town of Arborg accepts the current installation, then the contractor could be relieved from having to correct this deficiency;

AND WHEREAS, Council is not prepared to accept the deficient installation of the Standby Generator;
